### Language School

We have finished our second module and have taken our second exam. There was much consternation as to the outcome of the final grades. Praise the LORD we passed again. Lisa had an 84 and I had an 82. Passing two tests does not indicate that we can speak Polish or carry on a conversation with a stranger, but we are getting closer. We started A.2, our third module on February 19th and again ask for your prayers that we will learn what we should and retain what we have already learned.

### Residency Card

On January 27th we had an appointment with the immigration office to confirm our desire for Residency Cards and have our passports stamped stating our intent. Everything was in order, we were told that our filing was very organized, and our meeting progressed quickly without a hitch. We have been given an estimated date of April 27th for a decision of YES or NO on our cards. When we get a YES, we will then start filing for a 3-year ministry visa. This means we will need an already established organization to invite us into the country and serve as a ministry. There are some things involved that would have to be worked out, but this gives us our best opportunity to establish a church and not have to be concerned about whether we must leave the country at a year's end. We ask that you plead to the LORD for us that His will be done in this matter, and that a thriving, local, independent Baptist church for God's glory will be the outcome.

### Ministry

We continue to participate in the ministries of Gospel Baptist Church. We were able to participate in a Bible handout/street preaching in front of the Galerii (mall) near the church just before Christmas. Pastor Paul preached and many Bibles were freely given to curious and interested Poles. One man who received a Bible came out the next day to church and a young woman who recently lost her grandfather listened intently to the plan of salvation as it was presented. Pray for a man named Sunil who showed interest in coming to church. He is around my age and is in my Polish language class. May God bless us all, in Poland and the USA, as we present the gospel of Jesus Christ to the lost.
