Song of Solomon 3:1-4 *“By night on my bed I sought him whom my soul loveth: I sought him, but I found him not. (2) I will rise now, and go about the city in the streets, and in the broad ways I will seek him whom my soul loveth: I sought him, but I found him not. (3) The watchmen that go about the city found me: to whom I said, Saw ye him whom my soul loveth? We are excited that four more churches have decided to take us on for monthly support. This brings our promised support to over 50%. We look forward to another exciting year of expressing our burden and calling to Poland and seeing our great and wonderful God answer our prayers.
