We finished off the week visiting our son at Fairhaven Baptist College. It was an enjoyable time of fellowship with our son and the many other faithful pastors who were also there.

We spent all day November 12th with Pastor Jim Leslie in McConnellsburg, PA, at Bible Baptist Church. It is hard to believe that Pastor Leslie was born in the late 1980's during my time in Bible college. I have known him all his life and it is a blessing to consider his father, Dean Leslie, as a dear friend. What an encouragement to see Pastor Leslie, his family, and Bible Baptist Church making up a hedge for the people of their city.

On November 19th, we were with Pastor Andrew Almanza, whom I first met in Bible college when he was just a few years old. He is now pastoring Gospel Light Baptist Church in Millersville, PA, and they are doing well. After we spent Thanksgiving with my wife's family south of Pittsburg, PA, we made a quick trip back home to Quincy, IL. We were able to spend some time with my pastor/son, Daniel Zdziarski and his family along with our home church, Tabernacle Baptist. It was a joy to see those precious folks again and to participate in the Thursday night FBI children's ministry. Though God has taken the desire to pastor our former church away, there still remains a love and burden for them to remain strong for our LORD. Pray for our travels in December as we make our way from PA, to SC, to FL, and back to PA at the end of January for a Mission conference. Pray as we will be flying to Poland in February for a two week trip. Continue to stand in the gap and make up the hedge for the people God has placed around you. We may be the last hope that they will have. Let it not be said of us that God found no man willing to make up the hedge or stand in the gap.
